The Pre-hike Meal: Due to Fire restrictions, we'll do things a little different. 1:30-3:30: Cook & eat dinner: stoves are allowed at the trailhead but not in the backcountry. We'll also pack sandwiches for later in the evening.

The hike: Uphill hike to a meadow on a hill with beautiful views. There are picnic tables, and a rustic pit toilet. We will carry in all our water.

Gear: Borrow a pack, tent, sleeping bag & sleeping pad for free!
