

Prewett Point



Region: Monterey County (Pinnacles National Park)

Length: 1 mile round trip

Difficulty Rating: Easy

Elevation Gain: 78 Feet

Girls bring: Backpack, water, snack, hat, jacket, sunscreen, face mask.

Adults: Map/Info sheet, Required paperwork, first aid kit, phone (for pictures no cell service till you get back to Ranger station)

When to go: Year round, but there is no shade on the trail, so on warm days, hike in the early morning or evening only.

Getting There and Parking: Follow Google directions to West Pinnacles Visitor

Contact Station. Park at the Contact (Ranger) Station.

Bathrooms: Pinnacles Ranger Station has bathrooms.

Safety Considerations: none

Route Description (from alltrails):

This trail starts right out of the Ranger Station heading towards the pinnacles. The trail gently winds up up the hillside before you meet the first split. Either choice will take you around the loop.
